



## Graven Hill Primary School

### Opening September 2023



The Warriner Multi Academy Trust intends to open Graven Hill Primary School in September 2023. The primary school will take up to 90 nursery aged children and 60 reception in September 2023. Intake in subsequent years will be 60 reception children until the school is full in 2029. The school will be fully inclusive and open to all children from the Graven Hill development.

The aim of the Trust is to:

- Deliver academic excellence by placing the needs of all of our children at the heart of everything that we do
- Ensure that all of our children acquire the skills and enthusiasm to embrace the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life
- Develop a culture where mutual respect flourishes and our children develop an understanding, acceptance of and sensitivity to the needs of all others

The Warriner Multi Academy Trust is a family of 1 secondary and 7 primary schools, all of whom are rated Ofsted good or better. We have a proven track record in delivering the very highest standards for all of our children and will bring all of this expertise to Graven Hill Primary School. Our innovative “all through” curriculum and relentless focus on best practice in teaching and learning have been commended by Ofsted.

As part of the pre-opening process, the Trust is completing an appropriate (as set out in Section 10 of the Academies act, 2010) formal consultation exercise to determine whether we should enter into a funding agreement with the Department for Education, pending approval from the Secretary of State.
